The skinheads' most dedicated opponents include one of the strangest factions within Toronto's youth underground—a loose association of about 100 punk youths called Bunch of F---ing Goofs, who are centred around a local punk rock band of the same name. The Goofs

function like an urban commune, with some members living in a run-down Toronto warehouse, which the five band members also use as a recording studio. Many members sport Mohawk-style haircuts and wear studded leather armbands and vests and deliberately ripped T-shirts. "We could have been good white folk,"

said Steve (Goof) Johnston, who is the band's lead singer. "But we made the choice to be a visible minority. We fit right into Toronto's multicultural society because we've created our own ethnic group."

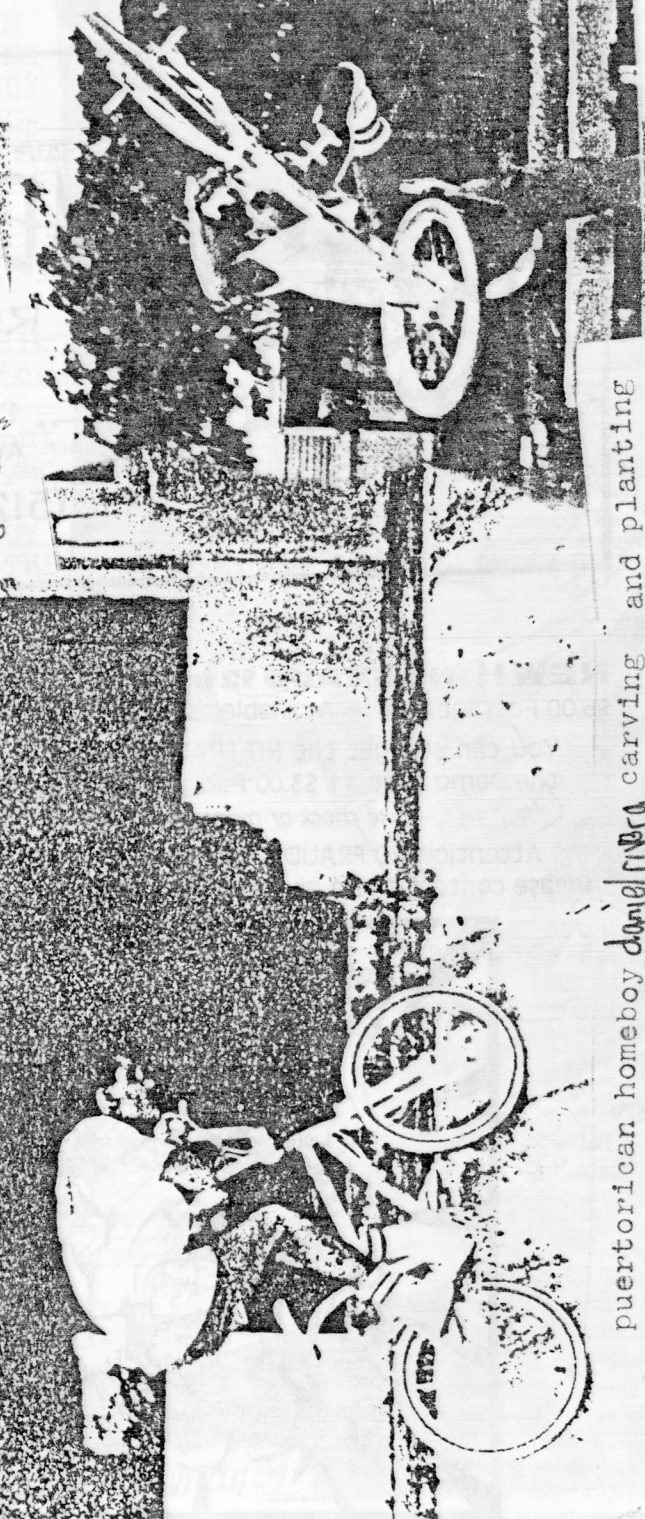
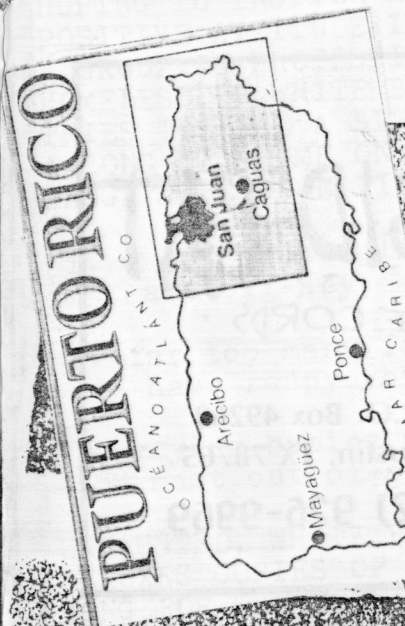
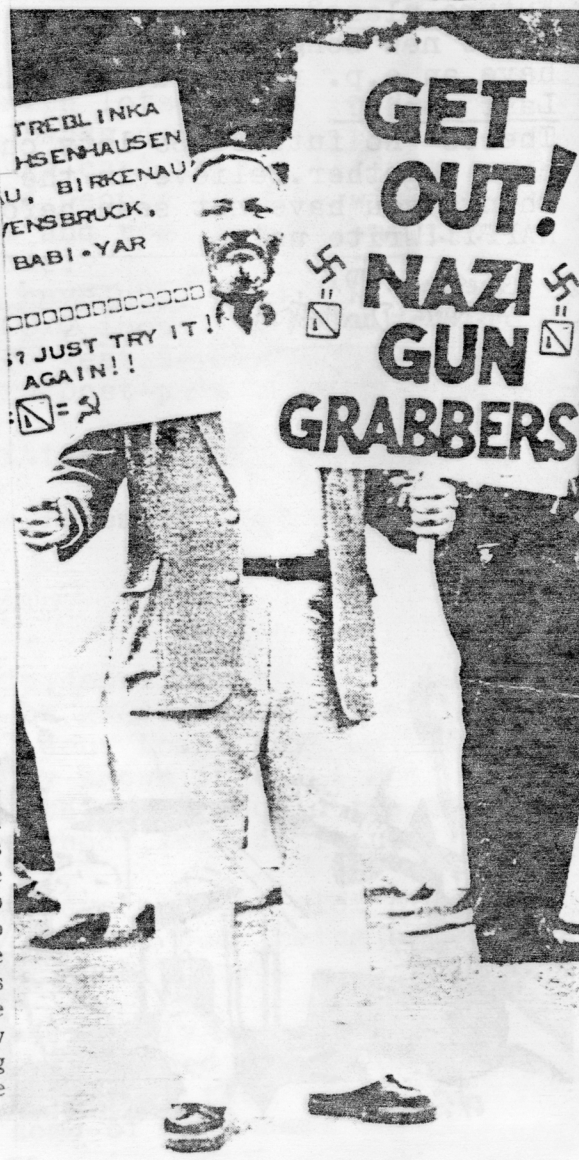
To the Goofs' expressed dismay, many members of the public regard them as part of Toronto's criminal youth gang scene. In fact, members of the commune insist that they are promoting social justice by opposing racism and dangerous drug practices ranging from glue-sniffing to heroin use. As well, the Goofs are enemies of The Untouchables and their imitators. "They are just a bunch of cheap criminals," said Johnston, who worked as a real estate agent before he helped found the Goofs in 1983. "Life should be about co-operation." Still, group members have engaged in numerous battles with skinheads during the past five years. Said one group member: "The last time I saw a skinhead was two weeks ago in my backyard. He sicked his pit bull terrier on my pit bull and then he started swinging a chain at my head. So I grabbed a two-by-four and cracked him over the head."

**Transients:** Despite their unpopularity, the skinheads are the originators of many of the fashions that other gangs have adopted for themselves. The skinheads' uniform usually consists of heavy Doc Marten work boots with red laces, black bomber jackets, white T-shirts and jeans with rolled cuffs. Many skinheads are unemployed transients, who regularly steal to survive. If they have a home at all, it is likely to be in a run-down rooming house. But as the number of youth gangs hostile to the skinheads has multiplied during the past two years, police say that the skinheads are now keeping a low profile. Like many of Toronto's law-abiding residents, they too are afraid to walk the streets at night.

Agnostic Front-Live at CBGB

Recorded in A.F.'s home ~~town~~, N.Y.C., at CBGB, Agnostic Front returns with a slightly revamped line-up, and one hell of a live album. This features 19 songs from A.F.'s albums and out-of-print "United Blood" e.p., and it doesn't disappoint!! A.F. rips through all their best, including "Victim in Pain", "Strength", "Toxic Shock", their cover of "Crucified", and "Blind Justice" (which features Roger's 12-yr old brother, Freddie singing). This is no cop-out live album!! A great album from a great band (in-effect)

H.R. - Tapes '84-'86

Side one contains "It's About Luv", originally released in 1984. The first few songs are intense punk tunes with H.R.'s screaming voice, and the last few are flowing reggae songs. Side two has "Keep Out of Reach" from 1986. There are only 3 songs (the title track, its dubversion, & "Power of the Trinity") but they are wickedly good, and remind me of the Bad Brains "I Against I" album. Totally worth getting ahold of! (SST)

SCRAPS - AAARGH! 7"

3 songs sung in French, 3 in English. Really powerful punk/hardcore from France. The lyrics deal with big business exploitation of music & people, cops, and such. Pretty good, I'd say if you can find it, get it. (AALTRACK)

NO FRAUD - 7" e.p.

Really great sounding hardcore from Florida. The songs deal with real problems, the music is polished, and vocals that don't get too bogged down with screaming, howling, etc. I especially think the drums are extremely good. But anyways get this and I know you won't be disappointed. (Truth Records)

M.O.D. - gross misconduct

Circus magazine called them "just another thrash band with nothing new to say. 'I think the Circus crew should stop listening to those faggot bands like Poison, Crue, & Bon Jovi (didn't the Cult have a song called "Bad Medicine" a couple of years back?) and listen to some real music. Buy it and mosh on!!

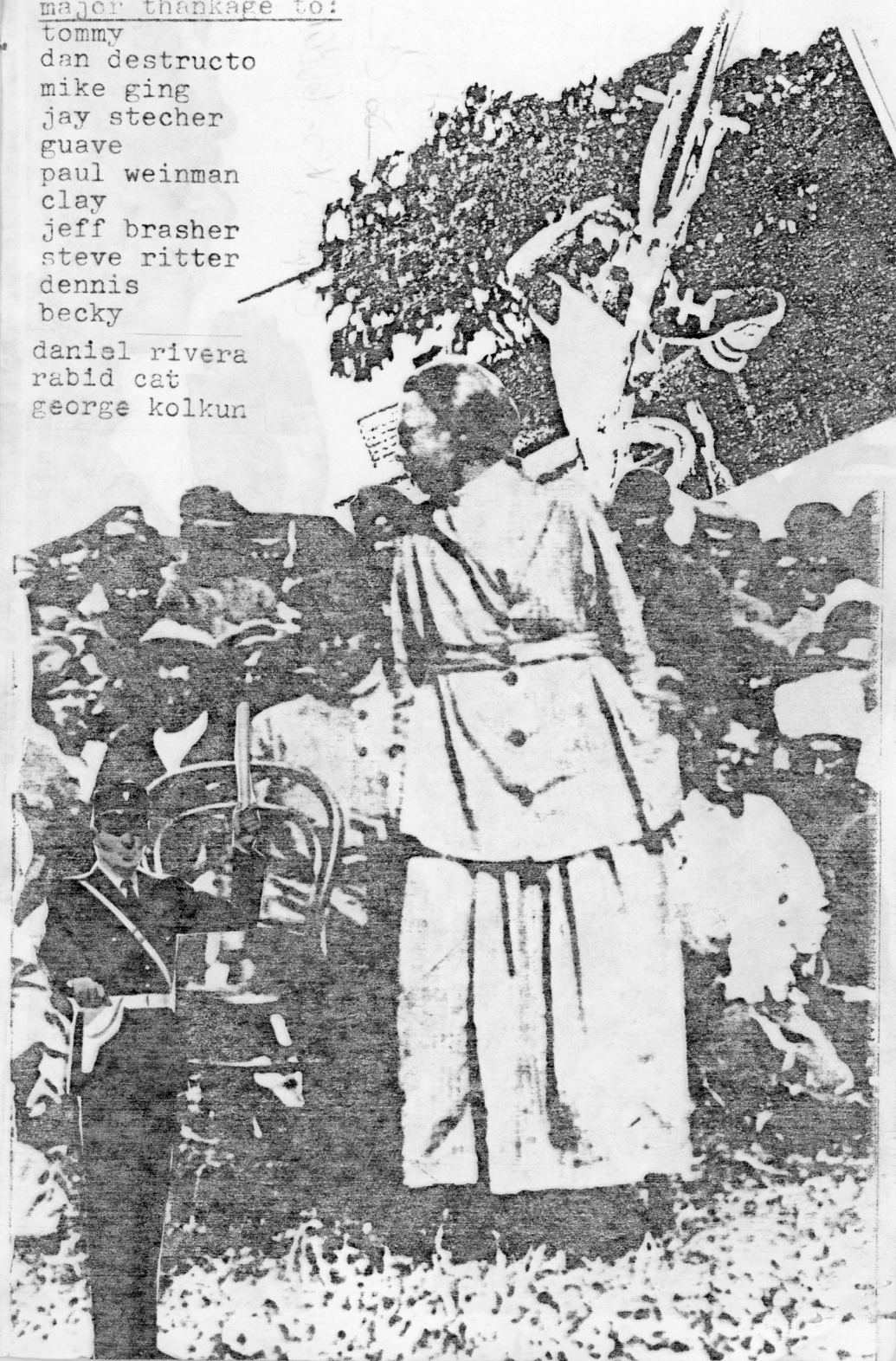
